

If you are a serious songwriter and or performing artist and would like to be a guest on the “Outpost Opry Show,” submit your package to J. & P. Productions. All submission must follow these steps to be considered. Once all the procedures are met the Producers of the show will screen your package to insure that your performance will fit the criteria and format of the show. We encourage musical comedians and comical characters to submit their material as well. If you are selected you will be notified and a performance date will be scheduled. All performers will be backed by the Outpost Opry House Band “The Major Dogs” if a full band is required. The “Outpost Opry Show” is pre recorded for radio so professionalism and high energy personality is a must.

Submission Requirements

The following material should be emailed to info@jnppro.com

1. Six mp3’s of the songs you wish to perform no more than two originals. Make sure your originals are copyrighted.

Lyric sheets to include Nashville Numbers over the lyrics. All lyric/chart sheets should be typed in word document font type Courier New, font size 16 pt. With a maximum of 28 characters per line. The entire song in the order of performance should be typed. If the Chorus is sung three times it must appear three times. This is so it will work in the teleprompter. (Example Click Here)

2. A professional photo, head shot is sufficient. Any photo with graphics such as an album cover or live shots may also be appropriate. You may submit more than one photo.
3. A complete Biography being no more than 500 words.

FAQ:

Can I bring my own band? No, due to quality control and because it is a live recording there is no time for a stage change.

Can I bring a musician? Yes, if you have a musician that is familiar with your material that can conduct the house band one player is allowed.

Can I bring back up singers? Yes, back-up singers are encouraged however no more than

two due to space.

What is the dress code? The Outpost Opry is a family show. We have performers wearing \$600 dollar shirts and some wear \$16 over-alls.

Will there be a sound check or rehearsal? Yes, the producer or stage manager will notify you of your sound check and rehearsal time.

Can I sell CD's and Merchandise at the show? Yes, there will be a designated area for artist to sell T-Shirts, CD's Coffee mugs ect. All artist, are encouraged to have a meet and greet at the end of the show.
